## Programs



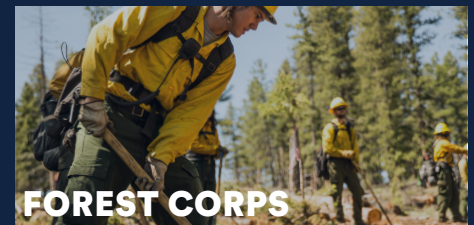
### TRADITIONAL CORPS

- Complete hands-on projects in a variety of areas
- Work alongside nonprofits, local and state government agencies, tribal organizations, and faith based groups



### FEMA CORPS

- Work with FEMA staff in an administrative capacity
- Support communities before, during, and after disasters
- Take a step toward federal employment



### FOREST CORPS

- Work on wildfire risk mitigation, reforestation, resource management, and wildfire suppression incident response
- Field based, rigorous work with the US Forest Service

## Position Options

### Team Leader

- For those with leadership potential, ages 18+
- Supervise, mentor, and guide a team of 8-12 AmeriCorps members

### Corps Member

- For young adults, ages 18-26
- Serve on a team of your peers
- Gain personal and professional experience

### During Service

- Basic expenses, including communal housing, meals, a modest living stipend, and a limited health benefit
- All program-related travel, including to your training location, projects, and back home after your service term
- Forbearance for federally backed student loan
